PHOTOGRAPHIC COMPETITION

Welcome to the Pytchley Photographic Competition. Attached are the rules of entry and a few notes. Please would all entrants get their photo(s) and entry form to Steve Booker by Friday 27th June to allow time to collate and set up the display in the village hall.

Judging will be at 4pm on Saturday 28th in the Village Hall, and prizes will be handed out immediately afterwards. There will be one prize plus one commendation per category.

The photos will be left on display for an open exhibition on Sunday 29th June.

Rules

- Exhibition will be open to all residents of Pytchley and anyone who has close connections with the village.
- All entries must be card mounted and be suitable for hanging/display on screens
- The longest side of the photograph or mount must not be less than 20cm (8") multiple pictures may be displayed on one mount and be classed as one entry.
- Entries may be in colour or black & white.
- All entries to be clearly marked on the rear with the name of the photographer, title or description, and the category entered.
- Entrants can submit any number of photographs per category
- An entry fee of £1.00 will be charged for each photograph in all categories except 'G' (Junior), which shall be 50p per photo.
- One prize and one commendation will be awarded per category as judged by the expert.
- Judging will be based on artistic content, quality, and relevance to the category.

Categories and requirements

A - Pytchley Village

This can be any subject that has relevance to the village; views, human interest, architecture, etc.

B - Portrait

Studio or outside shot, head and shoulders or full length, group or single subject.

C - Landscape

Images of stunning landscape views, weather conditions, freak occurrences etc.

D - Patterns & Textures

Photographs that demonstrate the use of colour, light, and shade as applied to natural objects; perhaps at odd angles.

E - Open

Open category to allow the photographer to demonstrate his/her approach to any subject.

F - Humorous

Any subject that has a humorous content.

G - Junior

Any subject, but the photographer must be under the age of 14 years at the time of the exhibition.
